

Bonus miles are not accrued for the following types of transactions:

- Cash withdrawals from ATMs or cash desks of organizations;
- Transfers from account to account;
- Payments or transfers to electronic wallets;
- Purchase of money orders, foreign currency, use of cards for opening deposit accounts, transactions in non-financial institutions;
- Gambling-related transactions — placing bets, purchasing lottery tickets, buying tokens (chips) or other instruments in exchange for cash, as well as payments for goods/services related to gambling in establishments such as casinos, racetracks, card houses, etc.;
- Purchase of insurance, guaranteed placement, or insurance premiums. Merchants selling insurance services directly by mail; offered insurance services may include all forms of insurance;
- Payments at pawnshops. Customers providing personal property in exchange for money;
- Money transfer transactions, where funds are delivered or made available to a person at a location different from where the transfer is initiated, including non-face-to-face transactions such as those conducted via the Internet;
- Payments for utility services — electricity, gas, water, etc.;
- Transactions related to telecommunications and information services;
- Bonus miles accumulated by the cardholder may not be sold, transferred, assigned to another person, or used other than in accordance with these rules;
- Bonus miles accumulated from the purchase of goods, works, and services become available for redemption in the following calendar month.

Bonus miles accumulated by the Mastercard World Elite cardholder may not be sold, transferred, assigned to another person, or used other than in accordance with the UzAirPlus loyalty program.
